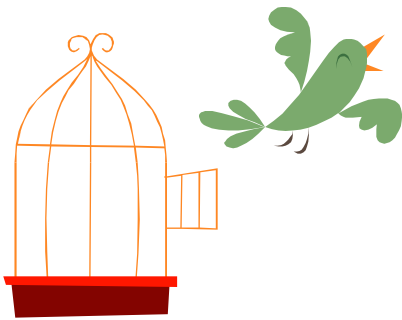


# Spring Program/BBQ

### **Mother's Day Gifts**

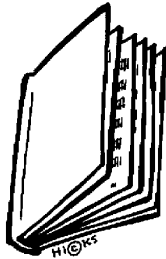
We have 2 fund raisers which may make perfect Mothers' Day gifts.
