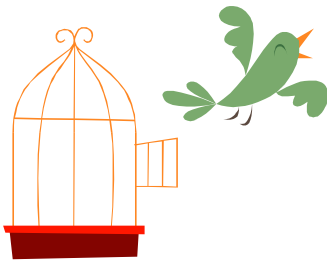


# Spring Program/BBQ

After working hard to meet the stringent requirements, some of our students have qualified to receive either the Presidential or National Fitness Awards. Presentations will be made at the end of the month.

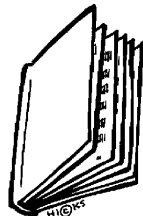
### **Used Uniform Sale**
