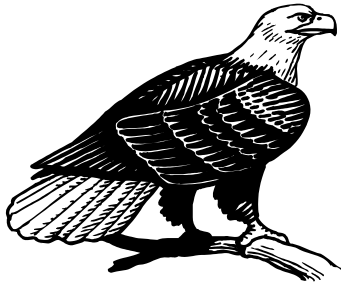

### IMMUNIZATION RECORDS BY OCTOBER 31<sup>ST</sup>

By law, we are required to have current immunization records for every student in our files. This is a government law by which we must abide. We have set October 31<sup>st</sup> as the deadline for submitting these records to the school office.

At that time, students not in compliance will be suspended until this requirement is met, or you have an appointment to get the shots completed.

As a note of interest, public schools do not even admit students without immunization records in hand.

### EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN

In order to be prepared in case of an emergency, each student is to have a Ziploc with 2 granola bars and a Mylar (silver) blanket. You may add some hard candy and a family photo. *Please do not include water in your Ziploc.* At the end of the year, Ziplocs are sent home.

### BIRTHDAY INVITATIONS

We would ask that children's feelings be of utmost concern when distributing invitations for birthday parties. 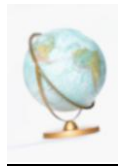
### HALLOWEEN REMINDER
